Performance notes:

Free interpretation is strongly encouraged, particularly for trills. Those may be fast or slow, accelerating or decelerating, they may last for the entire duration of the note or simply as mordents, and so on. Difficult passages may be practiced until they're smooth, or simply played "awkwardly", with short pauses and/or breaking of the flow. The same logic applies for glissandi: broken glissandi may be used not only where necessary, but also in other places. Vary the duration of fermatas and pauses that must follow them. Dynamics are approximate and may be changed in any way.
