Violin parts: Both Violin staves are silent, indicated by whole rests in every measure.

Viola part: Measures 1-4 contain whole rests. In measure 5, a trill (tr) is marked over a half note G. In measure 6, the trill continues over a half note F.

Cello part: Measures 1-2 contain a trill (tr) over a half note G. In measure 3, a grace note (grace) is marked over a quarter note G. The rest of the part consists of eighth and sixteenth note patterns.

Violin parts: The first Violin staff is silent with whole rests. The second Violin staff has a trill (tr) over a half note G in measure 7, which continues through measure 8.

Vln. Vln. Vla. Clo.
